The Global Down Syndrome Foundation (GLOBAL) is the largest non-profit in the U.S. working to save lives and dramatically improve health outcomes for people with Down syndrome. GLOBAL established the first Down syndrome research institute and supports over 400 scientists and over 2,500 patients with Down syndrome from 33 states and 10 countries. Working closely with Congress and the National Institutes of Health, GLOBAL is the lead advocacy organization in the U.S. for Down syndrome research and care. GLOBAL has a membership of over 110 Down syndrome organizations worldwide, and is part of a network of Affiliates – the Crnic Institute for Down Syndrome, the Sie Center for Down Syndrome, the University of Colorado Alzheimer's and Cognition Center – all on the Anschutz Medical Campus, and the GLOBAL Adult Down Syndrome Clinic at Denver Health.

GLOBAL's widely circulated medical publications include <u>Global Medical Care Guidelines for Adults with Down Syndrome</u>, <u>Prenatal & Newborn Down Syndrome Information</u>, and the award-winning magazine <u>Down Syndrome World TM</u>. GLOBAL also organizes the annual <u>AcceptAbility Gala</u> in Washington DC, and the annual <u>Be Beautiful Be Yourself Fashion Show</u>, the largest Down syndrome fundraiser in the world.

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
