GLOBAL's widely circulated medical publications include <u>Global Medical Care Guidelines for Adults with</u> <u>Down Syndrome</u>, <u>Prenatal & Newborn Down Syndrome Information</u>, and the award-winning magazine <u>Down Syndrome World TM</u>.
