While still playing for the Broncos, he established The McCaffrey Family Foundation, which strives to improve the lives of children, particularly in Colorado. The goal of the foundation is to assist children whose medical situation has created a hardship, whether financial or academic, and provide opportunities for children who show great promise through exceptional academics and hard work.

In 2001, the McCaffreys established the Ed McCaffrey Football Camp, which recently celebrated its ninth year by adding a
