# NEW Inclusive Scholarships at Regis University

Regis University announced more than \$365,000 in new scholarship funding for students with intellectual disabilities enrolling in the university's groundbreaking GLOBAL Inclusive Program. The program is one of only two in Jesuit colleges that offers a post-secondary certificate for those with intellectual and developmental disabilities. A combination of this new scholarship funding and a grant provided by the Anna & John J. Sie Foundation will help cover costs related to tuition, books and supplies, extracurricular activities, transportation, and room and board for in-state and out-of-state students in the program.
